Applications are invited from eligible candidates for engagement to the post of Technician (Electronics) at the Tura Digital Planetarium, NEHU Campus Tura, on a purely contractual basis.

Preference	Knowledge of the Garo language shall be preferred.
Consolidated Pay	₹25,800/- (Rupees Twenty-five Thousand eight hundred only) per month
Period of Engagement	1 (One) year on contractual basis
Age Limit	As per State Government Rules

Duties and Responsibilities

The selected candidate shall be responsible for the operation, handling and basic upkeep of the planetarium equipment and associated electronic and audio-visual systems; providing technical support during planetarium shows and educational programmes; identifying and reporting technical faults; maintaining basic equipment and operational records; and performing any other technical duties assigned by the competent authority.

Terms and Conditions

1. The engagement is purely temporary and contractual for a period of one year and shall not confer any right or claim for regular appointment, regularization, absorption or permanent employment under Shillong Science Centre or the Government of Meghalaya.
2. The engagement may be terminated at any time by the competent authority in accordance with the terms and conditions of the engagement.
3. No TA/DA shall be admissible for appearing in the written test, practical/skill test or personal interview.
4. Candidates shall produce all original certificates and testimonials relating to age, educational qualification, technical qualification and experience at the time of verification.
5. Applications that are incomplete, unsigned or received after the prescribed last date shall be liable to rejection.
6. The competent authority reserves the right to shortlist candidates based on qualification, relevant experience and suitability for the post.
7. Canvassing in any form shall lead to disqualification.
8. The selected candidate shall be required to work at the Tura Digital Planetarium, NEHU Campus Tura, and may be assigned duties at Shillong Science Centre during programmes, special events etc
9. The competent authority reserves the right to cancel, postpone or modify the recruitment process at any stage without assigning any reason.

Selection Procedure

The selection may consist of:

1. Scrutiny and short listing of applications;
2. Written Test, wherever considered necessary;
3. Practical/Skill Test relating to electronics, equipment operation, troubleshooting and computer knowledge; and
4. Personal Interview.

The final selection shall be based on the overall performance of the candidate in the selection process and verification of original documents.
